Reports & Updates

Technical Director Collins briefly reviewed previous FC meetings since October 2023 and presented instances of adding fire classification data mentioned in minutes, presentations, and strategic plans.

Mr. Collins then facilitated a discussion that continued from the October 2024 meeting. From the discussion, items to note:

- Continued to discuss two options for adding fire classification data: mimicking RoofNav's presentation of data or having a separate database containing fire classification data; and
- Task Force members raised further concerns and requested more information on how a separate database would function and be implemented before selecting a path to pursue.

Further member discussion asked for other concerns to be addressed before moving further and for a mockup of what a parallel fire database would look like. Mr. Collins committed to delivering these items at the April meeting.

Adjournment

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:00 p.m. ET.
