#### **Reports & Updates**

Informed group of WD-1 Canvass Results

- 12 balloted, 10 responses
- 8 affirmative, 2 negative

\*SPRI complies with antitrust laws and requires participants in its programs to comply with antitrust laws. Discussions which could affect competitive pricing decisions or other competitive factors are forbidden. There may be no discussions of pricing policies or future prices, production capacity, profit margins or other factors that may tend to influence prices. In discussing technical issues, care should be taken to avoid discussing potential or planned competitive activities. Members and participants should be familiar with the SPRI Antitrust Policy and act in conformity with it.

Discussed editorial changes made to the document to address negative comments, for example:

- Changed document title from "Wind Design Practice for Roof Assemblies" to "Wind Design Procedure for Non-Ballasted Roof Assemblies".
- Safety Factor of 1 assumed throughout the document text, not just the commentary;
- Extrapolation permitted to a maximum of 300% (per RAS / FBC);
  - 1 comment wanted an example of what this means -- added to main text
  - o 1 comment says this is too much -- nonpersuasive
- FM wanted to limit extrapolation on adhered systems to 90 psf -- added to Commentary B;
- Clarification between Zones 1', 1, 2 -- added to Commentary B

Discussed the next steps and whether re-canvass would be needed.

Agreed we need a very close to final document by 1st week of February for IBC.

Dan and Brian will finalize a new version of document and address each of the negative comments in writing next week.

Dan will send to Linda once completed for distribution to the Task Force and follow-up with Phil Smith.
