





Corporate Transparency Act

The broadest exemption is the Large Operating Company exemption. To qualify, the entity must:

- Employ >20 full time employees in the United States;
- Have a physical office/presence in the Untied States where it regularly conducts business, and;
- Have filed a federal income tax or info return demonstrating more than \$5 million in gross receipts or sales.

A total of 23 exemptions exist and cover banks, certain utilities, tax-exempt entities, and others (see question C.2 on FinCEN's FAQ for more)

The reporting requirement is currently on hold via a nation-wide injunction.
